- 2.1 The body of the email should contain the following particulars:
- Case no and Parties;
 - Date of order;
 - Names and contact details of both parties’ legal representatives;
 - Email addresses of both parties’ legal representatives.
3. The order will be provided per email within 5 court days of receipt of the request.
4. Once the new industrial scanners arrive the turnaround time for court orders will improve significantly.
