

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS: DEEDS REGISTRIES REGULATIONS BOARD AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS

The Law Society of South Africa (LSSA) hereby advises the legal profession that the current term of office of the members representing the legal profession on the Deeds Registries Regulations Board will expire on 31 December 2025.

In terms of section 9(2)(c) and section 9(3A) of the Deeds Registries Act, 1937 (Act No. 47 of 1937), the Legal Practice Council (LPC) must nominate:

- Two (2) conveyancers for appointment by the Minister of Land Reform and Rural Development as members of the Board, and
- Two (2) conveyancers for appointment as alternate members of the Board.

The Minister of Land Reform and Rural Development has expressed a preference for a Board that is representative of the race and gender demographics of the country and nominating bodies are therefore encouraged to take this into account when selecting candidates.

The LSSA invites all interested members of the legal profession to submit their applications. The applications must be accompanied by a comprehensive curriculum vitae of the applicant.
